

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The organisers do not hold themselves responsible for anything that may happen to competitors, spectators, their property, horses or servants in connection with or arising out of this event. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from any incident.

The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. In order for this to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions and obey the instructions of the organisers.

The organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel any of the classes as necessary. Dogs must stay on a lead at all times at the showground, and must be cleaned up after.

Hard hats/ crash helmets correctly fastened must be worn at all times when mounted. Body protectors are strongly recommended for all jumping events

The judge's decision is final. Objections accompanied by a deposit of £20 must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the incident. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

Ponies 15h and under most suitable for the job, may be required to jump a small jump in individual show

CLASS 11—Veteran/ Young stock

Class may be split if sufficient entries, horses 5 years and under and 15 years and over! May be led!
